Minutes

Chris Fleming welcomed members and introduced Smithcom facilitator Linda Smith to the group. Smithcom provides third party facilitation for all Dufferin CAP meetings.

Participant self introductions were made and Art Lyall - Treasurer of the Stewardship Council, and neighbours George Mitchell and Dave Murray were introduced to the group.

Linda Smith of Smithcom gave brief outline of facilitator role for Cayuga Community Advisory Panel (CAP) quarterly meetings.

Reviewed January 2012 meeting minutes, corrections will be made and the ammended minutes will be posted on the web site.

Terms of Reference was accepted by the members.

Chris Fleming presented an Operations and CSR update to the group and this presentation will be posted to the web site.

Quarry site tour given by Chris Fleming nine members joined Site Manager for a half hour tour and trip through the quarry for a close up look at the operations.

Jessica Davidson gave a Biodiversity Presentation for all of the South Western Ontario sites and cited the success of many Rehabilitated sites within urban areas for use by the local citizens.

George Mitchell questioned blast vibrations, Chris Fleming explained that the sites blasting program is monitored by Golder Associates and are within the guidelines of the Ministry of Environment.

John Furber has noticed increased traffic volume on Dry Lake road, Chris Fleming explained that we are transferring Aglime from Flamboro and this will be a short term project.

David Murray concerned with dust control, cause due to extremely dry conditions, new additions to water truck capabilities are being considered and calcium applications are in place to suppress dust.
